INVESTMENT FOR A STRONGER ECONOMY

RDA Hunter engaged Deloitte Access Economics in 2013 to research and write Prospects and Challenges for the Hunter Region. Forward estimates predict growth by 2036 of almost 75%, or a boost of nearly \$28 billion to the Hunter's economy.

The annual Hunter Investment Prospectus published by RDA Hunter presents the region's advantages to national and international markets in support of the government strategies to attract investment, facilitate exports, create jobs and grow the NSW economy.

Smart Happens Here is a campaign that demonstrates Hunter's competitive advantages and shows the benefits of making smart investments in the region. This RDA Hunter initiative takes geography out of the equation and raises our profile internationally.

SKILLED WORKFORCE: ADVANCED MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY SCHOOL PATHWAYS (ME) PROGRAM

RDA Hunter's ME Program encourages young people to complete science, mathematics, physics and engineering subjects to better prepare them for a highly skilled future workforce. In 5 years, 7,500 senior students in 25 Hunter high schools have been engaged with 32 defence and manufacturing companies.

- ME Program students 3% above state average for selecting HSC Physics
- 8% above state average ME Program students select HSC Engineering Studies
- 11% above state average ME Program students in Metals and Engineering Certificate II

RDA Hunter's award winning ME Program delivers the smart schools for the Hunter's future.

INFRASTRUCTURE TO INCREASE PRODUCTIVITY

The Hunter Economic Infrastructure Plan was developed in 2013 by RDA Hunter and Infrastructure NSW to identify road and water priorities that will sustain and grow the region's economy.

The Plan has Commonwealth, State and Local government support for priority solutions to the region's infrastructure needs, including:


- Duplication of Tourle Street Bridge

Hunter creative industries is a growing economic sector, with about 5,000 people employed in media production, performing arts, advertising and internet services.
